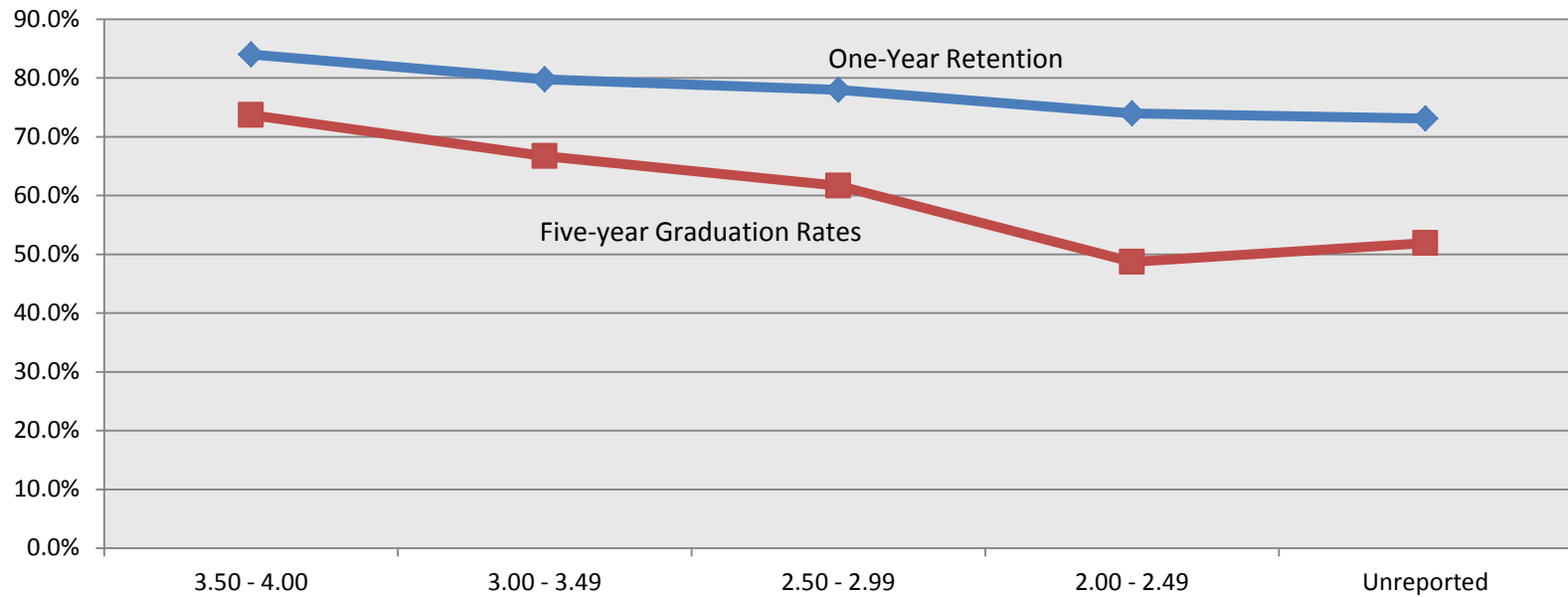

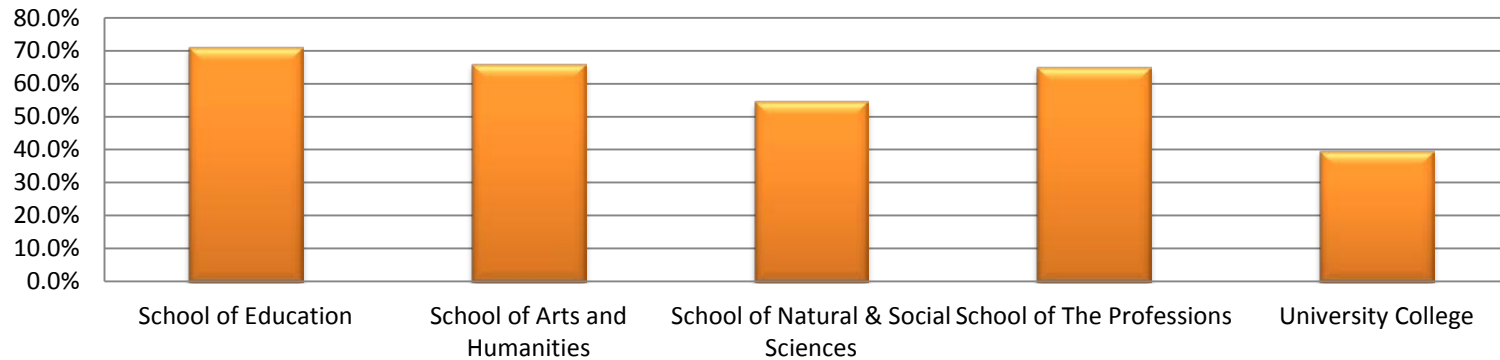
**Figure 3: One-year Retention and Five-year Graduation Rates
